The special meeting was called to discuss the role of Yellow Medicine County in the future of the Neighbor's United Food Shelf in Granite Falls.

Rae Ann Keeler-Aus, Family Service Center Director and Administrator Heglund discussed possible options for the board. The options presented were rental unit, purchase existing house and move, build new, Morton building or purchase business site on Main Street.

Morton Building 04-09-15-01 Motion by Commissioner Sherlin and seconded by Commissioner Berends to build a Morton building for the Neighbor's United Food Shelf in Granite Falls on County property. Commissioner Sherlin withdrew his motion after discussion.

Rent Building 04-09-15-02 Motion by Commissioner Antony and seconded by Commissioner Sherlin to contribute \$6,000 per year for two years for the operation of Neighbor's United Food Shelf in Granite Falls. Motion carried with Commissioner Antony, Sherlin, Renneke and Berends voting in favor and Commissioner Johnson voting against.
