		<p>*Empty aerosols and paint cans can be disposed of in the trash.</p>	
		<p>**Whenever possible, dry out unusable latex paint and dispose of in trash. Call for instructions.</p>	

Tips

- *Empty containers can be thrown into the trash.
- *Dried-out latex paint cans can be thrown away.
- *Empty spray paint cans and other aerosol cans are trash.
- *Alkaline batteries are trash.
- *LED or incandescent light bulbs are trash.
- *Used paintbrushes, paint mixing sticks are trash.
- *Box up items so that they don't tip over during transport. Do not bag items.
- *Trash is not accepted.

Other Items we accept at Clarkfield are:

- *Fluorescent light bulbs
- *Mattress and box spring
- *Farm Chemical Pesticide/Herbicides
- *Ballasts

Other Items accepted at Marshall (call for details):

- *Books
- *Shredded paper
- *Christmas lights and electrical cords
- *Car Seats
- *Styrofoam
- *Needles (sharps)-must be in a sharps container
- *Electronics
