

Yellow Medicine County Board Minutes

January 20, 2005

This special meeting was held at the Upper Sioux Community Tribal Governance Center and was called to discuss common issues, working cooperatively, and consider ways to enhance communications. Discussions commenced shortly after 8:30 a.m. Attending from the County were Commissioners Lynn Anderson, Ron Antony, Jane Remiger, Gary Johnson, and Louis Sherlin as well as County Administrator John Chatten and Assistant County Attorney Amanda Sieling. Representing the Upper Sioux Community were Chairman Helen Blue-Redner, Vice Chairman Teresa Peterson, Executive Office Manager Sandra Berthelsen, Attorney Leif Rasmussen, and Lobbyist Karen James.

There was a broad range of issues discussed including County support against State attempts to access gaming revenues or sponsor a metro casino, communications, establishment of quarterly meetings, and a variety of social service issues. All attending agreed that regular meetings in the future would benefit both the County and the Upper Sioux.
