Angie Steinbach and Dana Homan discussed the upcoming budget meetings for Commissioners and Department Heads.

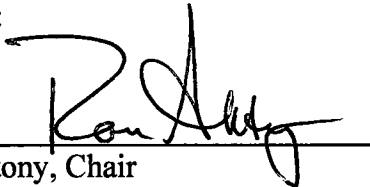
