

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SEPTIC SYSTEM WATERSHED LOANS TO BE PAID AS AUDITOR'S WARRANTS

WHEREAS, the Yellow Medicine County Board has authorized the County Auditor/Treasurer to issue warrants for incidental expenses for the Revenue, Road and Bridge, Bond and Ditch Funds; and

WHEREAS, incidental expenses include credit card expenses, utilities, telephone, Internet, taxes, postage, rents, bond payments, score recycling payments, monthly coroner payments, budgeted appropriation requests, SWCD wetland grant, licenses, fees, bulk fuel, partial payments to project contractors, VEBA fees, dental deductible reimbursements, drug testing costs, training/education registrations, board approved expenses authorized to be paid as auditor's warrants and other bills which require payment by a certain date and carry with them late fees and penalties for late payment; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to add septic system watershed loan payments to the list of expenses paid for as auditor's warrants as these expenses need to be paid by a certain date and a delay in issuing these payments can create a burden on the septic system installer.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yellow Medicine County Board of Commissioners authorizes the County Auditor/Treasurer to issue auditor's warrants for septic system watershed loans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authorization will be ongoing and will not need to be reauthorized annually.
